The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Vandegrift. The following Council Members were present: Logan Nance, Sara Hicks, Stacy Thurman and Kaye Nita Gallagher, Steve Simoff, and Mary Raglin. Also present were City Clerk Elizabeth Waterfill, Assist. Swearing in of council members - Mayor Vandergrift read the Oath of Office to council members: Mason, Hicks, Nance, and Gallagher. Each member raised their right hand while stating that they would uphold the Oath of office.

New Business

Approval of Regular Council Minutes -

November 7th – Motion by Council Member Thurman and seconded by Council Member Simoff to approve. Motion carried 6-0

November 21st - Motion by Council Member Nance and seconded by Council Member Raglin to approve. Motion carried 6-0

Application for Parade/Event – 6th Annual Race Rise and Midway Area Churches Marathon January 1, 2023. Motion by Council Member Hicks and seconded by Council Member Thurman to approve. Motion carried 6-0.

Resolution 2022-011 Accepting Public Streets within Midway Station. Request to hear by Council Members Hicks. Lucas Witt commented on the progress that has been made with regards to Midway Station since its inception. All lots have been sold. The City of Midway is now debt free from the project. Recommendation was made by Mayor Vandergrift to the council to consider a plan of asphalting by prioritizing streets taking one at a time rather than all at once. There was also discussion that some roads may be considered closed permanently. Motion by Council Member Hicks and seconded by Council Member Nance to approve. Motion carried 6-0.

Flag Committee Presentation of the Midway City Flag Winner of the design contest. The design of artist Tom McCoy resident of Nicholasville, KY was chosen by Midway residents via mailing/physical ballots. The chosen winner captured 67% of the votes tallied. A motion to adopt the flag was made by Council Member Nance and seconded by Council Member Hicks to approve. Motion carried 6-0.

Mayor Vandergrift read a proclamation of "Steve Simoff Day" to recognize outgoing council member Simoff. The mayor stated that he and the city are grateful for the two terms that he served.
