

**City of Midway City Council Regular Meeting
Monday, August 7, 2023, 5:30 p.m.**

The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Thurman. The following Council Members were present: Kaye Nita Gallagher, Mary Raglin, Dee Mason, Logan Nance and Patrick Hall. Council Member Sara Hicks was absent due to death in family. Also present were City Clerk Elizabeth Waterfill, Asst. City Clerk Sonya Conner, Versailles Police Rob Young.

Moment of Reflection – Mayor Thurman requested a moment of silence.

Citizen's comments – Cortney Neikirk spoke with Council regarding a storm drain that goes through her yard and is causing damage to her driveway. Pictures were presented.

Approval of Minutes –

New Business

Event Permit – Thriller Parade on October 29, 2023 – Motion by Council Member Nance to approve; Council Member Raglin seconded. All members voted to approve 5-0.

Encroachment Permit – Pumpkin Wagon on Gratz St. Starting after Fall Festival and running through Halloween. Council Member Hall motioned to approve; Council Member Mason seconded. All members voted to approve 5-0.

Tracie Wright with the Woodford County Road Dept. presented two options to the council for adding 4-way stops on E Stephens St., to try and slow dangerously fast driving on the road. One being a 4-way at Gratz and E Stephens. The other being the stop at S. Gratz and E. Stephens and an additional 4-way at S. Brand St. and E. Stephens. No action taken at this time.

Fire Station/EMS Bids – Three bidders submitted bids for the fourth time advertising this project. Motion to approve Brett Construction Company bid in the amount of \$3,410,073 by Council Member Nance, Council Member Mason seconded. All members voted to approve 5-0.

Old Business


