The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following council members were present: Steve Simoff, John McDaniel, Bruce Southworth.

Council Members Libby Warfield and Kaye Nita Gallagher was absent due to illness.

Council Member Sara Hicks arrived at 5:37pm

Motion by Council Member John McDaniel and seconded by Council Member Sara Hicks to adopt the February 5, 2018 regular meeting minutes. Motion carried 4-0.

John Soper with the EDA spoke to the council regarding there being three industrial clients looking at Midway Station. He is focusing on smaller to mid-sized companies of interest.

New Business

Event Permit – Midway Business Association. Steve Morgan was present to answer questions that council may have pertaining to the St. Patrick's Day Parade downtown on March 17, 2018. There are some discrepancies with the route for the parade so the Midway Business Association is going to revamp the route and present it again at the March 5, 2018 Regular Meeting.

First Reading of Ordinances

Ordinance 2018-002 Amending Section 110.15 of the Code of Ordinances Pertaining to Business After Midnight. Request to read by Council Member Bruce Southworth. Read by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift. Second reading will be at March 5, 2018 Regular Meeting.

Old Business

Midway Business Association – Merchant's request for donation toward interstate signage. Motion by Council Member John McDaniel to donate \$300.00 toward the cost of signs. Motion died due to lack of second motion.


Winter Street Traffic – A letter from Natalia McMillan, PE; Traffic Engineer to Mayor Grayson Vandegrift states that the Department of Highways, District 7 will be adding edgelines through town on Winter St. The edgelines will tie into existing ones, and will narrow the driving lanes and encourage drivers to slow down. This will also allow the city to add angled parking spaces beside City Hall rather than parallel parking spaces which will create more parking for downtown. A recommendation was also made for adding curb extensions or bulb outs to extend the sidewalk area at the intersections. This will also benefit by shortening the crossing distance for pedestrians. These could be designed and built via the permit process if the city chooses to do that.

Committee Reports

Mayor Grayson Vandegrift requests that since Council Member Libby Warfield, Chair of the Cemetery, City Property & Blighted Property Committee is out, that the remaining Council Members on the committee discuss the building of a Cemetery Pavilion near where the old Cemetery House used to be.

Motion by Council Member Bruce Southworth and seconded by Council Member Sara Hicks to adjourn.
