The regular meeting of Midway City Council was called to order by Mayor Grayson Vandegrift and the following council members were present: John McDaniel, Kaye Nita Gallagher, Sara Hicks, Johnny Wilson and Steve Simoff.

Motion by Council Member Sara Hicks and seconded by Council Member Kaye Nita Gallagher to adopt the November 19, 2018 Regular Meeting minutes. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business

Kentucky American Water – Jimmy Keeton, Director of Governmental Affairs, presented Midway Fire Department with a check of \$500 for the Kentucky American Water's 2018 Firefighting Support Grant. He said that Kentucky American Water has had a long-standing partnership with Volunteer and Professional Fire Departments. Assist. Chief Joe Campbell was present to receive the check and said the money will go toward education.

Request for Annexation – 1132 Georgetown Rd., Midway, KY. Bill Moore, Attorney for Homer Michael Freeny has sent a letter to the City of Midway requesting Annexation of 137.743 acre tract. They have currently filed an application by the owner, Homer Michael Freeny, Trustee to rezone the property from its current A-1 zone designation to the I-1 zone designation. Mayor Grayson Vandegrift stated that the property is already in the future Comprehensive Plan.

Encroachment Permit – 301 South Turner. Motion to approve by Council Member Johnny Wilson and seconded by Council Member John McDaniel. Motion carried 6-0.

John's Bluegrass Racing Company, LLC. Zachary Beavin and Riley Marshall notified the Council they would like to change the Iron Horse Marathon date to the Sunday of Fall Festival weekend. The date will be September 22, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:04 p.m. They have already gotten approval from Midway Merchants Association who put on the Midway Fall Festival. Motion to approve by Council Member John McDaniel and seconded by Council Member Steve Simoff. Motion carried 6-0.


